**In order to consider this application, this form must be completed, signed, dated, accompanied by an official academic transcript with class rank and SAT/ACT scores and all letters of recommendation. All of these must be received by the application deadline.**

The Hamaty Scholarship Fund is established at St. George Orthodox Church by means of a generous gift from the estate of Michael G. Hamaty. The scholarship fund serves as a living memorial to Mr. Hamaty, whose intentions were to help others and also provide assistance to youth as they pursue advanced academic studies at an undergraduate degree program in an accredited college or university. Selection of the recipients is based on the following criteria.

- The candidate must be a graduating high school senior who is accepted to an accredited college or university. In either case, the candidate must be a full time enrolled student.
- The candidate must be a member in good standing of St. George Orthodox Parish West Roxbury, MA either through a family membership or as an individual pledging member.
- In awarding the scholarship consideration is given to the following factors:
  - Parish involvement and service – e.g., Christian education graduate, teen SOYO member, participation in Diocesan activities (bible bowl, oratorical contest) services to the parish (choir, altar server), Antiochian Village participate and/or CIT.
  - Academic merit – e.g., academic record, GPA, class standing, SAT/ACT performance, honors and awards
  - Community service – e.g., school service programs, scouting, community programs
- Applicants must submit an official academic transcript including grades, rank in class and SAT/ACT scores with this application. See below for details.
- Two (2) letters of recommendation from such persons as faculty, employers, pastor, church lay leader must accompany the application.
