SCHOLASTIC ACHIEVEMENT AWARD – YEAR 2020
(Please read carefully)

SECTION I - GENERAL

1. Scholastic Awards shall be made available to the youth of our Arab American community.
2. The number of Scholastic Awards and the amount of each will be recommended annually by the Scholastic Awards Committee to the Executive Board.

SECTION II - ELIGIBILITY

1. All applicants must be the child of a member of the Arab American community, satisfying the basic requisites and the priority categories stipulated in paragraph 2 of Section IV.
2. The applicant should be a current high school senior, planning to attend an accredited four-year college full time.

SECTION III - HOW TO APPLY

1. Applicants must fully complete the attached application form and attach an official signed transcript of their high school records.
2. No tests will be required, but applicants are urged to take the College Entrance Examinations (SAT or ACT) since they are part of the scoring. SAT or ACT scores should be submitted along with the high school transcript.
3. Completed application forms must be **postmarked by June 1st** of the year of application. **Late applications will not be accepted.**

SECTION IV - SELECTION OF AWARD RECIPIENTS

1. Recipients will be chosen anonymously by the Scholastic Awards Committee on the basis of school activities, academic achievements and non-school activities as indicated on this application. Students should indicate whether their parents or grandparents are members of the Nicholas G. Beram Veterans Association or veterans of the U.S armed forces.
(Please do **not** submit letters of recommendation, etc.)
2. Read this application carefully, and when presenting information for each category (i.e. Academic Achievements, School Activities, etc.), write **ONLY** about that category separately, and do not combine categories in one statement
